As summer begins to wind down our attention is quickly turning to the new school year and a new sports season. The Sidney High School Athletic 200 Club plays a big part in providing for the entire Sidney City Schools Athletic Department.

This marks the 20th year in existence for the 200 Club. The 200 club was started in 1990 to help fund construction of the new weight room at Sidney High School and is still going strong thanks to the Sidney community. In that time, the club has worked with the athletic department, head coaches, and the individual sports booster groups to donate over \$19,000 in equipment and awarding of \$40,000 in scholarships to over 70 female and male athletes. The club has purchased items in the following sports:

Soccer: new game goals, portable goals, misc. training tools; **Track/Filed:** Long jump pit, portable timer clock, portable shelter tent
Football: blocking sleds, weight room equipment, power racks; **Basketball:** breakaway rims, shoot-around machine, press box in gym, scoreboard at Middle School, **Softball/Baseball:** portable sliding pit, pitching machine, dugouts and infield sod at SHS field, scoreboard, brick dust; **Wrestling:** mat reconditioning, new mat; **Golf:** umbrella, bags; **All sports:** numerous video equipment

A \$1,000 donation was also made to Project Excel t hat helped create the Soccer complex at the SHS track and funded a new computer lab in the High School.

All the purchases made are supplemental in request. These items are typically not budgeted for by the High School Athletic Dept.

Your \$100 contribution would be very important in continuing the 200 Club and the support that it gives to ALL our athletic programs. Your \$100 includes the following:

- * Club is managed by a chairman, 14 Varsity Sport representatives and the Athletic Director.
- * 10 monthly drawings of \$50.00 each.
- * The club sponsors 2 parties for the members, who are paid in full, and their spouse or guest.
 - The first party will be held on Friday October 30 immediately following the football game with Troy at the Sidney Elks Club. Hamburgers, Hot Dogs, Chips, Chili, and Beverages.
 - The year end dinner party will be held in May of 2010. (Actual date and time will be announced later in the year.) At this party we will announce the scholarship winners for the current year and have our final year end drawings.
- * Each year the club awards four \$500 scholarships to Senior student athletes of active members. Two female, and two male
